
Change is inevitable. The future is just lurking around the corner. This is my appeal to the seniors (including me of course), that lets give a chance to the next generation.

MACHINE SAFETY

WHY DO WE NEED MACHINE SAFETY?

THE PROPER MAINTENANCE OF A MACHINE IS ESSENTIALLY, IF IT IS TO HAVE A TROUBLE FREE AND LONG USEFUL WORKING LIFE. WITHOUT REGULAR MAINTENANCE, A MACHINE COULD LITERALLY GRIND TO A HALT, OR PRODUCE INACCURATE WORK PIECES AND MORE IMPORTANTLY, BECOME DANGEROUS TO USE. REGULAR MAINTENANCE AND SAFETY CHECKS ARE A LEGAL REQUIREMENT.

One of the major causes of accidents occurring on worksites is the misuse of machinery.

Moving machine parts can cause severe injuries such as crushed body parts, burns, blindness, cuts and sometimes loss of life also.

This is why most dangerous machinery has builtin or attached safety guards.

We will discuss the different types of safety guards in brief, the purpose of the guards, when working with dangerous machinery in respect to electrical equipment.

THERE ARE FOUR TYPES OF GUARDS

- 1) Fixed
- 2) Interlocking
- 3) Self-Adjusting
- 4) Adjustable

Each one has different purposes.

FIXED GUARD

This is a permanently fixed guard that is part

of the machine. Machines will have fixed guards whenever possible because they provide the best level of protection.

INTERLOCKING GUARDS

These guards will automatically shut off or disengage the machine when the guard is opened or removed. You cannot use the machine again until the guard is put back into position.

SELF-ADJUSTING GUARDS

These guards adjust depending on the size and movement of the material. The guard will move out of the way to allow the material to pass through or, in the case of a saw, when the material is being cut.

ADJUSTABLE GUARDS

These guards can be adjusted when required to accommodate different sizes of the material to be worked on or cut. The downside is that accidents are more likely to happen due to human error.





SAFETY LIGHT CURTAINS :

Safety light curtains protect personnel from injury and machines from damage by

creating a sensing screen that guards machine access points and perimeters. An individual or object interrupting any beam in the screen will trigger a halt to the hazardous motion.



SAFETY CONTROLLER: 2.

A safety controller monitors multiple safety and non-safety input devices, providing safe stop and start functions for machines with hazardous



motion. A single safety controller can replace multiple safety relay modules in applications that include E-Stop buttons, safety light curtains, interlocking gate switches, and other safety input devices.

TWO-HAND CONTROL DEVICES : 3.

By requiring that a machine operator use both hands to initiate and continue a machine cycle, two-hand control devices keep the operator at a safe distance from the hazardous

motion of the machine. If one or both hands are removed from the device, the machine de-energizes, bringing the hazardous motion to a stop.

INDICATOR LIGHTS: 4

Available in single and multicolor options, LED indicator lights provide high-visibility real-time indication of equipment and safety status. They have a compact, low profile design that enables deployment in areas where other indication solutions would interfere with machine motion.

5. **SAFETY SCANNER :**

Safety laser scanners protect personnel and equipment within a user designated area.



GSTR 9 DUE DATE ANNUAL RETURN FOR FY 2022-23

Below the GST norms, the GSTR 9 annual return form is applied to all the usual assessees where all the related information of SGST, CGST and IGST transactions of the whole year needed to be furnished.

WHAT IS GSTR-9 ANNUAL RETURN?

GSTR 9 is a yearly return that is to be furnished annually through the assessments below GST. Some facts must have to be kept in mind such as:

It includes information about the outward and inward supplies furnished or concluded during the previous year beneath distinct tax councils such as CGST, SGST & IGST, and HSN codes. It is a merger of all the monthly or guarterly returns (GSTR-1, GSTR-2A, GSTR-3B) furnished in a particular year. It is however harder but this return assists in the boundless adjustment of data for 100% clear declarations.

WHO SHOULD FILE GSTR-9, THE ANNUAL RETURN?

All the assesses enrolled below GST must file their GSTR 9. Although the mentioned below items are not needed to file the GSTR-9:

Taxpayers opting for composition scheme (They must file GSTR-9A)

IMPORTANT NEWS

- **Casual Taxable Person**
- **Input service distributors**
- Non-resident taxable persons
- Persons paying TDS under section 51 of the CGST Act.

GSTR 9 DUE DATE, LATE FEE AND PENALTY

The late fee for not furnishing the GSTR-9 form within the left date is Rs 100 per article per day. It reveals that late fees of Rs 100 below CGST and Rs 100 beneath SGST will be liable for late cases.

Rs 200 per day is subjected as a sum liability for failure. It is entitled to a highest of 0.25% of the assessee's turnover in the related state or union territory. But till now there is no late fee on IGST.

WHAT IS THE INFORMATION NEEDED TO BE FULFILLED IN THE GSTR-9?

The GSTR-9 is divided into 6 parts and 19 sections. Every part questions the information that is simply present from your previously furnished returns and account books.

- On the buying portion, the yearly value of inward supplies and ITC claimed is to be reported.
- information of ITC which is required to get interchanged is to be entered as of the ineligibility.

COMPLIANCE BURDEN REDUCED FOR SMALL TAXPAYERS

For turnovers up to 2 crores and 5 crores, the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) has waived the filing of annual returns through Form GSTR-9 and GSTR-9C. During the 6th anniversary of the implementation of the Goods and Services Tax (GST), the announcement was made.


