- 3. Government has not given any substitute product in exchange of plastic
- 4. Government must provide the collection center to dispose the plastic waste, as it not possible for each trader to collect the same and send to the center.
- 5. For recycling the plastic, government should give incentive for the land, plant and machinery
- 6. Also they should mandatory promote the use of these recycle plastic in their departments.
- 7. Before implementing any such bans, government must build infrastructure for smooth transition.

EMA truly believe such interaction will build the confidence among small merchants to raise the voice and help each other.


