TECH KNOWLEDGE - CAPACITORS

What is a capacitor ?

Capacitor is an electronic component that stores electric charge. The capacitor is made of 2 close conductors (usually plates) that are separated by a dielectric material. The plates accumulate electric charge when connected to power source. One plate accumulates positive charge and the other plate accumulates negative charge.

- The capacitance is the amount of electric charge that is stored in the capacitor at voltage of 1 Volt.
- The capacitance is measured in units of Farad (F).
- The capacitor disconnects current in direct current (DC) circuits and short circuit in alternating current (AC) circuits.

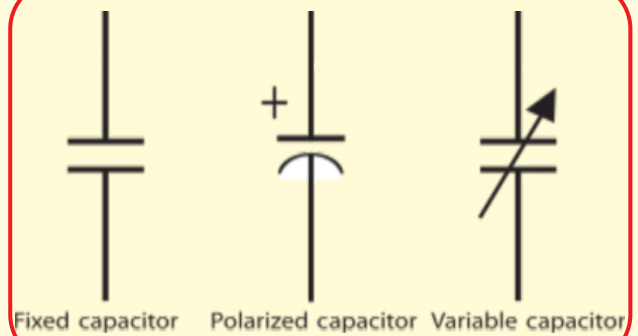
Power capacitors are passive electronic components that provide a static source of reactive power in electrical distribution systems. They consist of two conducting plates separated by an insulating material called the dielectric. Multilayer dielectrics provide excellent temperature stability and frequency characteristics. Single layer dielectrics are also available. Capacitance, a measure of energy storage ability, is typically expressed as $C = KA/D$, where A is the area of the electrodes, D is their separation, and K is a function of the dielectric between the electrodes. Power capacitors are used in:

- The Aerospace and Automotive Industries
- Power Factor correction and Lighting circuits
- Power Supplies
- Motor Starters

Some devices can handle one-phase voltages while others are designed for three-phase voltages.

Materials

Selecting power capacitors requires an analysis of dielectric materials. Aluminum electrolytic capacitors are polar devices that feature a high volumetric density but cannot withstand reverse voltages. Ceramic capacitors are made of resistive ceramic materials and provide bonded metal contacts. Examples include ceramic Z5U, a Class III ceramic dielectric, and ceramic X7R, a temperature-stable material that is suitable for bypassing and coupling applications. Glass, mica, oil, air, and paraffin paper are other commonly used dielectric materials. Polycarbonate, polypropylene, and polystyrene are suitable for applications such as fillers

and timers. Tantalum, a metallic element, is used to make a variety of alloys. Niobium, a hard ceramic material characterized by high conductivity, has similar chemical properties to tantalum.

TECH KNOWLEDGE - CAPACITORS

Specifications

Performance specifications for power capacitors include capacitance range and capacitance tolerance, a percentage of total capacitance. Other considerations include:

- working DC voltage (WVDC)
- working AC voltage (WVAC)
- rated current
- power rating
- dissipation factor
- insulation resistance
- temperature coefficient

WVDC and WVAC are, respectively, the maximum DC and AC voltages that can be applied continuously at any temperature between a lower category temperature and the rated temperature. Rated current is the maximum current and power rating is the maximum power that can be applied continuously across these same temperature intervals. The dissipation factor (DF) is the ratio between the resistive and reactive parts of a capacitor's impedance when a sinusoidal voltage at a specified frequency is applied. Insulation resistance is the ratio between an applied DC voltage and the resulting leakage current. The temperature coefficient is the change in capacitance measured over a range of temperatures.

Features

Power capacitors can use axial, radial, flying, tab, screw, gull wing, or J-leads. Some devices bolt into place while others require or include mounting brackets. Pole-mounted capacitors are also available. Surface mount technology (SMT) adds power capacitors to a printed circuit board (PCB) by inserting component leads through holes in the board and then soldering the leads in place on the opposite side of the board. Through hole technology (THT) mounts components on a PCB by inserting component leads through holes in the board and then soldering the leads in place on the opposite side of the board.

Power capacitors are packaged in tape reels, trays or rails, shipping tubes or stick magazines, and in bulk packs. Tape reel assemblies include a carrier tape with embossed cavities for storing individual components. A cover tape seals the carrier tape in place and the composite tape is wound on a reel that can be loaded into industry-standard, pick-and-place board assembly equipment. Power capacitors with leads on four sides are often packed in trays or rails that are made of carbon-powder or fiber materials and molded into rectangular outlines that contain matrices of uniformly spaced pockets. Shipping tubes or stick magazines are containers made of rigid polyvinylchloride (PVC) and extruded in industry-standard sizes. Bulk packs are used to distribute components as individual parts.

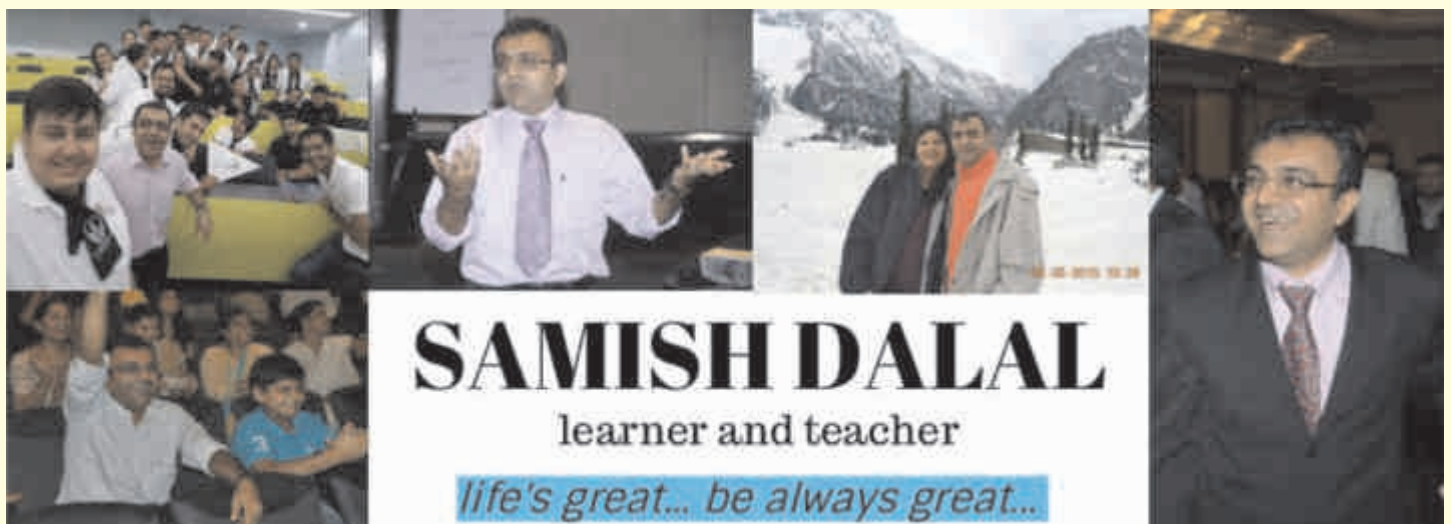

TAX UPDATES

Income Tax Return (ITR) Filing deadline for FY 19-20 extended till December 31st.

The income tax return (ITR) filing deadline for FY 2019-20 has been further extended to December 31, 2020, for most individual taxpayers, from the earlier deadline of November 30, 2020. This is the second time the tax return filing deadline for FY 2019-20 has been extended.

As per the government's press release issued on October 24, 2020, "In order to provide more time to taxpayers for furnishing of their ITR, it has been decided to further extend the due date for furnishing of Income-Tax Returns as under:

Due date for furnishing of income tax returns (ITR) for these individual taxpayers [for whom the due date (i.e. before the extension by the said notification dated June 24, 2020 as per the Act was 31st July, 2020) has been extended to 31st December, 2020.

The due date for furnishing of income tax returns for the taxpayers (including their partners) who are required to get their accounts audited [for whom the due date (i.e. before the extension by the said notification dated June 24, 2020) as per the Act is 31st October, 2020] has been extended to 31st January, 2021.

The due date for furnishing of income tax returns for the taxpayers who are required to furnish report in respect of international/specified domestic transactions [for whom the due date (i.e. before the extension by the said notification dated June 24, 2020) as per the Act is 30th November, 2020] has been extended to 31st Jan. 2021.

Consequently, the date for furnishing of various audit reports under the Act including tax audit report and report in respect of international/specified domestic transaction has also been extended to 31st December, 2020, said the government in a press release.

Further, relief is provided to small and middle class taxpayers in the matter of payment of self-assessment tax, the due date for payment of self-assessment tax date is hereby again being extended. Accordingly, the due date for payment of self-assessment tax for taxpayers whose self-assessment tax liability is up to Rs 1 lakh has been extended to 31st January, 2021 for the taxpayers whose accounts are required to be audited and to 31st December, 2020 for the taxpayers whose accounts are not required to be audited."

Income Tax Return (ITR) Filing : Essential Documents to finalise Tax Return

Filing an income tax return (ITR) involves a lot of documents related to the taxpayer's finances. These documents may not be required for submission, but are essential to finalise the ITR.

Below are the different documents that are needed for filing ITR.

PAN card and Form 16 : PAN card and Form 16 are crucial for ITR filing and must be kept handy. Form 16 is issued by the employer and includes details like salary, various allowances and the tax deducted at source.

Form 26AS : Form 26AS picks up the tax deducted at source by different entities and paid to the Income tax authorities on behalf of the taxpayer. This form can be downloaded from <https://www.incometaxindiaefiling.gov.in/home> or <https://contents.tdscpc.gov.in/en/taxpayer-home.html> or the taxpayer's internet banking website.

To claim deductions for expenses or investments, proof like receipts, certificates or account statements need to be maintained. Documents related to investments and redemptions/ sale of mutual funds, shares, and other securities also need to be put together to ascertain the income from capital gains. Mutual fund consolidated statements, transaction statements, contract notes issued by the broker can be referred to for the same.

Interest certificate : The interest certificate needs to be obtained from each bank where the taxpayer holds a savings or FD account. One can also download the same using the internet banking or collect a physical copy from the bank branch.

Home loan documents : In case of an ongoing home loan, the interest certificate issued by the financing bank or company, is the document to refer to.

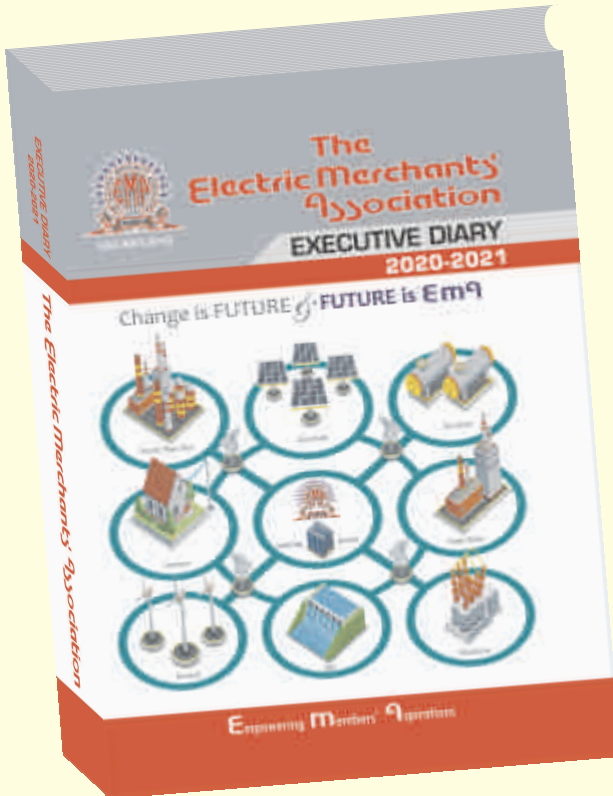
Points to note

- Each individual may need a different set of documents depending on his/her sources of income.
- Aadhaar card is mandatory for filing return and in case the same has been applied for, the enrollment ID needs to be quoted.
