APRIL 2025: MONEY-RELATED CHANGES THAT WOULD AFFECT TAXPAYERS, INVESTORS FROM THE NEW FINANCIAL YEAR

Direct Taxes

As Finance Bill 2025 has been enacted with notification of Finance Act 2025, here are key changes in the Income Tax will come into effect from Tuesday and will be reflected in the Income Tax Returns for Assessment Year 2026-27:

INCOME TAX REBATE

For individuals opting for the new Income Tax regime, the limit of total income to avail of rebate under section 87A will now be ₹12 lakh as against ₹7 lakh. This means an individual earning up to ₹12 lakh will not be required to pay income tax. In other words, any individual earlier was required to pay a tax of ₹80,000 (in the new regime) for an income of ₹12 lacs. Now, he will not be required to pay tax on such income. However, this does not mean they will be out of the Income Tax net. they will continue to file Income Tax Returns.

SALARIED PERSON

The limit on total income, added by the standard deduction of ₹75,000, will mean a salaried person will not have to pay income tax on total annual income up to ₹12.75 lakh under the new Income Tax Regime. However, she/he will be required to file an Income tax Return.

MARGINAL RELIEF

This will be applicable for individuals who earn (after total deductions) a total income of more than ₹12 lakh but up to ₹12.75 lakh . These individuals will get the benefit of marginal relief and will be required to pay only marginal a amount of tax equal to the amount of income above ₹12 lakh so that their carry-home is also ₹12 lakh. For example, if total income is ₹12.10 lakh, then tax liability will be ₹10.000, and so on.

The maximum rebate available is ₹60,000 which is there for a taxpayer having income of ₹12 lakh on which tax is payable as per the new slabs.

REWORKED STRUCTURE UNDER NEW IT REGIME

Along with rebates, slabs and rates under the new IT regime have also been changed. Now, there will be 7 slabs (₹0-4 lakhs, ₹4-8 lakhs, ₹8-12 lakhs, ₹12-16 lakhs, ₹16-20 lakhs, ₹20-24 lakhs and more than ₹24 lakhs). This means there will not be tax on income up to ₹4 lakh (earlier ₹3 lakh) and maximum rate will come into effect for income above ₹24 lakhs (earlier ₹15 lakhs)

Please note there is no change in rates for corporate tax and old Income Tax regime

END OF EQUALISATION LEVY

There will be no equalisation levy (EL) or digital tax on online advertisements starting April. The levy is charged at 6 per cent in respect of the sum received or receivable by a non-resident for online advertisement services. In 2020, EL was also imposed on non-resident e-commerce operators. The rate was 2 per cent, but it was removed in 2024.

F. TDS ON INTEREST INCOME

Threshold for TDS (Tax Deducted at Source) on bank interest for senior citizen (individual with 60 years of age or more) will now be Rs 1 lakh as against Rs 50.000. For non senior citizen, the threshold will be Rs 50,000 as against Rs 40,000. Similarly, dividend/income threshold for TDS has been doubled to Rs 10000.

G. TCS ON MONEY SENT ABROAD

Threshold for TCS (Tax calculated at source) for remittance under LRS (Liberalised Remittance Scheme, which allows sending \$250000 abroad without approval from RBI) has been raised to Rs 10 lakhs as against till date limit of Rs 7 lakhs. Same threshold will be applicable for spending on overseas tour program.

INDIRECT TAXES: GST

a. Mandatory new Input Service Distributor mechanism It will be effective from April 1. It will be mandatory for offices receiving tax invoices towards receipt of input services (including RCM transactions) for or on behalf of distinct persons. These offices must obtain ISD registration and distribute credit through prescribed documents in accordance with the GST framework. Till date, businesses had the flexibility to distribute common input tax credits through either the ISD mechanism or a cross-charge model.

B. MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION (MFA)

It will be mandatory for all GST assesses for the generation of e-way bills and e-invoices. This required login using a username, password, and OTP (sent to the registered mobile number, Sandes app, or similar platforms)

NOTICE UNDER RULE 25 (C) INVITING NOMINATION FORMS FOR ELECTION OF THE PRESIDENT AND TWELVE MEMBERS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE FOR THE YEAR 2025-2026

This is to hereby inform to all the members, that the Nomination form for the post of President and 12 Members of Managing Committee will be issued from Monday, 2nd June 2025. Members please take note that only local members would be eligible, to contest election. Election shall be held only in the



event of the Association receiving more valid nomination forms than are required. Such nomination form will be issued from 2nd June 2025.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Proprietor / Partner / Director / Manager or the Principal Officer of the Member - Firm, whose name appears as an authorised nominee in the Register of Members of The Association, as on 31st March, 2025 is eligible to contest the above election [Rule 25 (b)]. A Member contesting for the president is NOT entitled to $contest for the \, Membership \, of the \, Managing \, Committee.$

NOMINATION FORMS:

The Authorised Nominee of the Member-firms who wish to contest the election are requested to obtain a prescribed nomination form from the EMA's Office, available from Monday, 2nd June, 2025 during office hours, against a written request on the firm's letter head, indicating clearly if they wish to contest for the post of the President or the Membership of the Managing Committee. These nomination forms duly completed in all respect and signed by the intending contestant, proposer and two seconders, must be deposited in the box provided at the EMA's office from 2nd June 2025 to 7th June 2025, The nomination forms must be deposited on or before 5.00 pm. on last date i.e. Saturday, 7th June 2025 after which the box will be sealed by the Commissioner. (LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED).

Please note that the contestant, the proposer and the two seconders must be the authorised nominees of the Member-firms, whose names are listed in the register of Members maintained in the EMA's Office. Further, necessary rubber stamps must be affixed for signature and addresses of the contestant / proposer/seconders. In their own interest, the contestants are requested to carefully read and follow the instructions printed in the Nomination Forms before completing/depositing it in the box.

WITHDRAWALS:

If any of the contesting candidate wishes to withdraw from the Election, he/she shall inform the Hon. Secretary of the association in writing on or before 13th June 2025. To facilitate the intending contestant, nomination cards of the authorised nominee of the Member Firms are available for inspection up to 31st May 2025; in the EMA's Office up to 5.00 pm.





RULES

MANAGING COMMITTEE:

The Managing Committee shall consist of: President, Ex-Officio, 12 Members duly elected and 3 Co-opted Members, making a total of 17.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO CONTEST FOR ELECTION:

- 1. A Member shall have no right to contest for any position unless member has paid the Annual subscription fees, for the current year.
- 2. Proprietor/Partner/Director/Manager or Principal Officer (Manager of Principal Officer shall be person who is holding valid general power of attorney to operate Bank Account of the Firm), whose name appears as an authorised Nominee of the Member-firm in the Register of the Association as on 31st March 2025 will be eligible to contest the election of the Managing Committee.
- 3. A Member who has completed at least 3 years as an elected Managing Committee Member, having worked as an Office Bearers for a minimum period of one year or Past President is eligible for Presidentship.
- A Member who contests for the Presidentship is not entitled to contest for the Membership of the 4. Managing Committee.
- A Member contesting for Managing Committee seat should be a Member of the EMA for the minimum 5. period of 2 years.
- 6. Members are requested to check their official address registered with EMA office. If address differ, member's form is liable to be rejected.

NOMINATION FORMS

Candidates standing for the election shall fill up their nomination forms on the prescribed forms duly signed by themselves and proposer and two seconders (Nominee of Member firms) and then put the said form in the Ballot Box kept at the Association's Office, Nomination forms completed in all respect are to be submitted to the Associations Office and put in the Ballot Box latest by Saturday, 7th June 2025 on or before 5.00 pm. Incomplete form will be rejected.

WITHDRAWALS

If any of the Contesting Candidate wishes to withdraw from the election, he shall inform the Hon. Secretary in writing on or before 13th June 2025 before 5:00 pm.

EXAMPLE OF AN AUTHORIZED NOMINEE

Example of an Authorized Nominee for purpose of proposing and seconding is as follows: "Suppose a Member-Firm consists of Partners or Directors, viz. A.B.C. etc. and firm has nominated 'A' as their authorised nominee to represent their firm at the Association, the signature of 'A' only will be considered valid for the purpose of proposing or seconding. The signature of other Partners or Directors will not be valid for this purpose.

If Manager or the Principal Officer of the firm is appointed as the Authorised Nominee of the firm, his/her signature will be valid for the purpose of proposing or seconding".



EVENT COMMENCEMENT











NOTABLE RULE CHANGES




- Bowlers were required to bowl within the square box with one foot forward.

emerged victorious, securing their spots in the final match.


FINAL MATCH AND WINNER






